

# Integrated Pest Management at Home

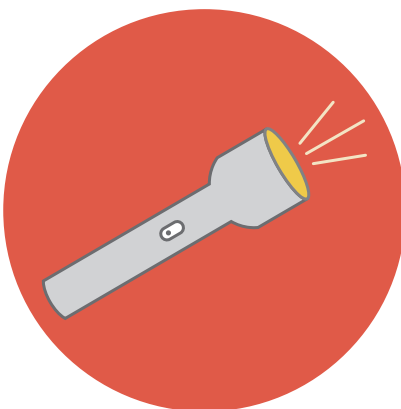

## Inspect Often



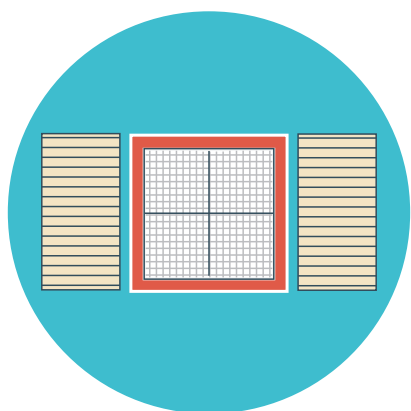
Frequently inspect your home. Early action can stop damage and save you money.

## Remove Pest Needs



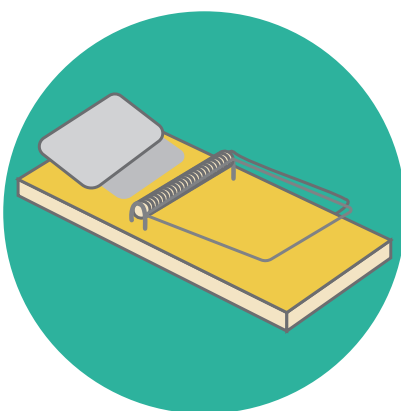
Remove access points, clutter, free food, and water to keep pests from moving in.
