TO: Pesticide Product Registrants

SUBJECT: REGISTRATION FEE BRIEFING

The Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) has determined it is necessary to raise registration fees for pesticide products. A briefing to discuss the issue is scheduled for January 14, 2015 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in the Coastal Hearing Room at the following location:

Food and Agricultural Code (FAC) §12812(a) states “The director shall establish, by regulation, fees for the Department of Pesticide Regulation's registration program, as established pursuant to this division. The fees shall include, but are not limited to, the following: (1) annual fees for each product submitted for registration; (2) penalties for the late payment of registration fees; and (3) fees for amendments to registered products.” Additionally, FAC §12812(c) states “The fees established pursuant to this section shall be set so that the total revenue collected each fiscal year is sufficient to support the expenditure levels for the registration program....”

For a number of reasons to be explained at the briefing, DPR finds that the current levels of registration fees will be insufficient to support expenses over the next three years. At the end of that time period, DPR plans to again assess its registration fee levels. An agenda is attached.
