Notes:

- 61006-00 greenhouse fumigation is now expanded to include greenhouse fumigation/sanitization to include applications to tables, racks, etc.
- Commodities indicated as forage/fodder include feed and silage uses. For example, oat forage/fodder (22006-00) also includes feed and silage.
