Amend Chapter 1.2, Section 3 and Appendix in Division 1 of Title 3 to read:

Chapter 1.2. Department of Pesticide Regulation – Conflict-of-Interest Code

The Conflict-of-Interest code is designated as Chapter 1.2 of Division 1 of Title 3 of the California Code of Regulations, and consists of sections numbered and titled as follows:

Chapter 1.2.	Department of Pesticide Regulation--conflict-of-interest code
Section 3.	General Provisions Appendix

Amend Chapter 1.2, Section 3, and Appendix in Division 1 of Title 3 to read:

DEPARTMENT OF PESTICIDE REGULATION
CONFLICT-OF-INTEREST CODE

The Political Reform Act (Government Code Sections 81000, et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict-of-interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, (2 Cal. Code of Regs. Sec. 18730) that contains the terms of a standard conflict-of-interest code, which can be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing, the standard code may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference., This regulation and the attached Appendices, designating positions and establishing disclosure categories, shall constitute the conflict-of-interest code of the **Department of Pesticide Regulation (Department)**.

Individuals holding designated positions shall file their statements of economic interests with the **Department**, which will make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction. (Gov. Code § 81008.) Upon receipt of the Director's statement, the **Department** shall make and retain a copy and forward the original to the **Fair Political Practices Commission**. Statements for all other designated positions shall be retained by the **Department**.

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*Consultants are included in the list of designated positions and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the code, subject to the following limitation:

The Director may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a “designated position” is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope, and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant’s duties, and based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Director’s determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict-of-interest code. (Gov. Code § 81008.)

APPENDIX B
DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

1. Designated positions in this category shall disclose all investments and business positions in business entities, interests in real property, and sources of income, including gifts, loans, and travel payments.
2. Designated positions in this category shall disclose all business positions in business entities, investments, and sources of income, including gifts, loans, and travel payments, from sources that are of the type to be regulated by the Department. Such sources include persons that apply for any license, permit, certificate, or registration issued by the Department.
3. Designated positions in this category shall disclose all investments and business positions in business entities and sources of income, including gifts, loans, and travel payments, of the type which, within the previous two years, have contracted with the Department to provide services, supplies, or materials.
4. All interests in real property and investments and business positions in, and any income, including gifts, loans, and travel payments from, a business entity, professional association or individual where the business entity, professional association or individual's profession is regulated by or offers programs or courses qualifying for licensing or continuing education credit by the official's or employee's licensing agency.
