

Project Title: Improving efficacy of biologically mediated soilborne disease management in strawberry by the use of reduced rate fumigations

Project Description: Soilborne diseases are a significant yield limiting factor in strawberry production systems and are the primary reason that strawberry growers annually fumigate their soil. Increasing regulatory restrictions on fumigants have created an urgent need to develop alternatives that will reduce dependence on chemical fumigation in strawberry production. Research on non-fumigant alternatives has not been completely successful in controlling all major soilborne diseases in California strawberry. A strategy that combines the use of fumigants at reduced rates with biologically active soil treatments in sequential combination may produce options that are more effective and significantly reduce the amount of fumigant used to manage soilborne diseases. This project will examine effects of integrating fumigation and biological soil treatments such as anaerobic soil disinfestation (ASD) and mustard seed meal (MSM) on soilborne disease management for strawberry production in California.
