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- a. Dr. Swett presented her grant project "Reducing fumigant use in processing tomato by enabling use of resistant cultivars to manage Fusarium diseases".
- VI. Research Grant Q&A Leslie Talpasanu, DPR
 - a. Dr. Swett answered several questions from the members.
- VII. **PMAC Charter Discussion** Lynette Komar, Staff Counsel
 - a. Ms. Komar presented the revised PMAC Charter.
 - b. There were a number of questions, especially from UC Cooperative Extension members, regarding the following sentence "Additionally, Committee members must not score, discuss, or vote on any grant application submitted by a university where the Committee member is a salaried faculty." There was concern that the large number of UC and Cooperative Extension employees on PMAC would be excluded from voting, depending on how this language was interpreted. It was suggested that the language be re-worked and clarified to reflect that Counsel's intent was that exclusion would be necessary based on consideration of grants linked to a member's specific campus employment, rather than general employment affiliation with a university system. Ms. Komar indicated that DPR will be looking at this language to better clarify its intended meaning.
 - c. DPR will update the Charter to address PMAC member questions and will present the final document for adoption at the next PMAC meeting on February 11, 2021.
