SUBJECT: PUBLIC WORKSHOP AND OPENING OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
FOR ENDOSULFAN, A POTENTIAL TOXIC AIR CONTAMINANT

The Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) announces the opening of the public comment period for the preliminary report entitled "Endosulfan-Risk Characterization Document". DPR staff prepared this risk characterization document (RCD) pursuant to the mandate of Assembly Bill 1807, the law that established a procedure for the identification and control of toxic air contaminants in California.

The RCD contains ambient air exposure and other exposure scenarios. This comprehensive risk assessment covers worker, residential, ambient air, and dietary exposures when appropriate, to address DPR's responsibility under several different statutes to address the health risks of pesticides. While the RCD includes all exposures, public review, and comments should focus on bystander exposures, since these are the ones relevant to the toxic air contaminant program.
