TO: PESTICIDE PRODUCT REGISTRANTS

SUBJECT: EXISTING STOCKS POLICY FOR AMENDED LABELS

Effectively immediately, the Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) will allow a registrant to continue to sell and distribute in California a U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) registered pesticide product bearing a previously DPR-approved version of an amended product label, provided the sale is consistent with U.S. EPA's existing stocks provisions.

If DPR finds as a result of an audit or investigation that a registrant has sold a U.S. EPA registered product bearing a previously DPR-approved label, and a new amended label for the same product is on file with DPR, the registrant should be prepared to document that such a sale was made within the period allowed by U.S. EPA's existing stocks policy to avoid potential liability for a misbranded sale.

With this policy, DPR would like to encourage registrants to submit amended pesticide labels to DPR for acceptance immediately after federal approval.
