SUBJECT: RESCINDING CHEMICAL-SPECIFIC PESTICIDE SAFETY INFORMATION SERIES (PSIS) LEAFLETS, REVISION OF PSIS A-8 & A-9, AND ADOPTION OF PSIS A-10 (MINIMAL EXPOSURE PESTICIDES)

The Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) has posted the attached Notices of Final Decision to adopt, rescind and revise certain PSIS leaflets with the Resources Agency. WH&S Notice 95-4 concerns the adoption of PSIS A-10 on Minimal Exposure Pesticides. DPR has also revised PSIS A-8 and A-9 to include a listing of the currently registered pesticide active ingredients that are on the Proposition 65 list (WH&S Notice 95-6). WH&S Notice 95-5 finalized the decision to rescind all of the chemical-specific PSIS leaflets.

Please discard all copies of the PSIS leaflets listed in WH&S Notice 95-5. These PSIS leaflets will no longer be available from DPR. The Pesticide Enforcement Branch has revised the requisition form (PR-ENF-197) to reflect these changes (copy attached). Also attached is the current PSIS index for your information.

Revisions to incorporate the worker protection standard requirements into the remaining PSIS leaflets will be incorporated when the worker protection standards regulatory package has been approved. 




