SUBJECT: REVIEW OF DDVP PRODUCT LABELS FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE
MITIGATION MEASURE STATED IN THE DEPARTMENT'S
MITIGATION DOCUMENT FOR DDVP

There were 20 product labels submitted by the Registration Branch to determine whether they comply with the mitigation measures stated in the Department's mitigation document for DDVP. Of the attached 20 product labels, five labels do comply with the mitigation measures. The other 15 labels require one or more of the following in order to mitigate the potential hazards of exposure:

1. Prohibit all indoor residential and institutional uses (such as homes, apartments, condominiums, schools, boats, hotels, locker rooms, offices, hospitals, restaurants, and stores).
2. Require a 24-hour reentry interval following use in warehouse and other enclosed structures.
3. Require applicators to wear coveralls over work clothing and chemical resistant gloves, except for products with automatic application devices. Applicators should also wear a half-face respirator when inside enclosed structures.

The products requiring no further mitigation are:

 ELASTREL INSECTICIDE (4691- 145-AA)
