SUBJECT: Review of EPTC Product Label, Eptam[®] 7-E (Received by Pesticide Registration on January 24, 2003)

At your request, we have reviewed the language of the EPTC product label, Eptam[®] 7-E, from Syngenta. The proposed language, particularly the highlighted portions of the label, appears to be appropriate.

The label also indicates requirements (mitigation measures) for the use of this product in California (Western Region) as follows: "In California, refer to the supplemental label for additional mitigation measures for Handlers and Applicators." Basically, the words "and Applicators" are not needed since applicators are handlers. The mitigation measures were developed as a result of the risk assessment of EPTC (Eptam[®]) performed by the Department of Pesticide Regulation.

Recommendation: Register as requested by Syngenta

(Mitigation/EPTC 7-E label)
