

Monterey County's resource cards in Spanish include the following content

Page 1

Monterey County Agricultural Commissioner phone number, website, and assertion that the CAC can help with pesticide questions or concerns.

Advice to call 911 in the case of a pesticide emergency.

Page 2

Monterey County Agricultural Commissioner phone number and website.

Information about workers' rights related to pesticide incidents and illnesses, including:

- A worker's right to report a pesticide incident to the CAC without any repercussion from their employer;
- What to share when reporting a pesticide incident; and
- The employer's responsibility to take a worker to a doctor if they are sick due to a pesticide exposure.

Page 3

The option for an essential agricultural worker to list their name.

A description of COVID-19 symptoms, encouragement to take a free coronavirus test if one is experiencing any symptom, phone numbers and hours of operation for Spanish-speaking nurses at local hospitals, advice to call 911 if one is experiencing chest pain or difficulty breathing, and assurance that essential agricultural workers have the right to receive medical care.

Page 4

A list of resources and programs for essential agricultural workers with contact information and hours of information, including: a local referral hotline for public services, food stamps, food banks, CDC medical information, county department of health, local childcare center, and local medical clinics.

Assurance that essential agricultural workers have the right to receive help.
