TO: DPR License and Certificate Holders with last names starting with M-Z

SUBJECT: CORRECTION TO YOUR RECENTLY MAILED LICENSE/CERTIFICATE RENEWAL APPLICATION PRINTOUT

Recently in the mail you received from the Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) your individual license/certificate renewal application. The instructions request that you complete the application (DPR-PML-141 (Rev. 6/15)). This application includes the correct number of **“Required CE hours to renew all licenses and certificates.”** However, directly below that, an error occurs on the application. The space that you are supposed to use to **“Enter the number of CE hours you have completed”** was inadvertently filled out by the database system with default numbers. To fix this, please cross out the pre-filled default numbers, and update the application to reflect the actual number of hours you have completed in each of the CE categories. These totals must correspond to the CE hours and information you submit on the Continuing Education Record Renewal Summary form (PR-PML-123) that accompanies your renewal application submittal.

Below (see arrow) is the section that has the error.
