The Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) has completed a human health risk assessment involving all pesticide products registered in California containing the active ingredient diquat dibromide.

DPR has determined, using current toxicity and exposure data, that the calculated margins of safety are greater than values conventionally considered to be protective of human health. Therefore, no further mitigation measures are needed for diquat dibromide.


