Always Read The Label

The label provides information on how to safely use the product.

Always Wear Required Personal Protective Equipment!

Wear safety glasses or goggles, chemical-resistant gloves, and work clothes.*

Never Store Pesticides in a Food or Beverage Container



* Specific personal protective equipment (PPE) must be worn as indicated on the product label.

What is a Pesticide?

A pesticide is any substance intended to control, destroy, repel, or attract a pest, and includes insecticides, fungicides, herbicides, rodenticides and sanitizers.
