

What is SprayDays California?

Across California, our farming communities work to produce and protect our food supply. And if you live or work near agricultural fields and wonder when pesticide spraying might happen nearby, there's an easy way to stay informed. It's called SprayDays California - a free notification tool from the California Department of Pesticide Regulation.

SprayDays was built because Californians want information that's easier to access and easier to understand about pesticide use near them. It helps families, neighbors, and workers know when a restricted material pesticide application is being planned in their area - so you can make more informed choices.

On the SprayDays website, you can use an interactive map to see recent and upcoming applications planned on farms across the state. You can look up a neighborhood - or type in an address. You'll see details like the intended date, pesticide ingredients, and application method.

You can also sign up for notifications - by text, email, or both - in English, Spanish, and other languages. You can track one or more addresses or map sections - like your home, a school, or a family member's address - and you'll get an automatic heads-up when an application is being planned nearby.

The SprayDays site is also a place to learn about pesticide safety, how restricted materials are regulated in California, and where to find additional resources.
